Desired member qualities:

The County values lived experience, community knowledge, volunteer work, cultural knowledge, and grassroots leadership alongside professional experience. Applicants do not need formal education, technical expertise, or government experience to be considered. We encourage applications from individuals representing historically under-served, disproportionately impacted, and underrepresented communities.

Members must live in San Diego region and meet at least one of the following criteria for a diversity of perspectives and experiences:

- Residents with lived experience of environmental injustices
- Local Tribal members
- Youth ages 16-24
- Organizational leaders from health, social, economic, or environmental fields that focus on equity
- Academics or researchers with expertise in addressing the underlying causes of health, social, economic, or environmental disparities in unjustly impacted communities
- Other self-identified characteristics to strengthen representation for groups often marginalized or under-represented in public processes (i.e., people who identify as BIPOC, LGBTQ+, youth, immigrants and refugees, unhoused, low-income, or live in an unincorporated or rural area)

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
