


Single Stream Recycling Guide





Why is Recycling Important in Baltimore?

- Recycling turns materials that would otherwise become waste into valuable resources.
- It helps sustain our environment and conserves energy.
- Recycling prevents pollution through the decrease of greenhouse gas emissions and preserves natural resources.
- It protects and increases the number of manufacturing jobs while generating revenue for Baltimore City.

Recycling is as easy as 1, 2, 3.

- 1. Use any container you want: paper bags, cardboard boxes, or old laundry basket. You can even use trash cans (just mark it "recycling"). The only rule? Do not place recycling in plastic bags.
- 2. Fill your container with recyclables: paper, cans, cardboard, and bottles.
- 3. Put out all the recyclables you can. There are no limits.
