Workday Supplier Self-Service Portal

The City of Baltimore launched a new Supplier Self-Service Portal to offer a better way to connect and do business. **This new portal is now open and replaces Citibuy.** The portal is a free, self-service tool that will allow suppliers to register with the City's Workday Supplier Portal and directly access their information during the "procure-to-pay" lifecycle.

Our secure self-service portal will offer you the ability to:

- View and create invoices from purchase orders
- Access payment and remittance advice information
- Maintain master data such as contact info, addresses and bank accounts
- Respond to requests for quotes (RFQ)

The Workday Supplier Self-Service Portal will create a higher level of connectivity that:

- Ties together business processes in a way that creates real-time visibility to important information.
- Requires no technical set-up by your company and is accessible via a secured website: high speed Internet is the only requirement.

 - **Please note: Temporary passwords are only valid for 90 days.**
