On July 31, 2022, at approximately 1638 hours, Baltimore Police units were dispatched to 3310 Lake Ave for a call of a shooting. Once in the area, units located a black male later identified as Trevon Williams (1/25/1992) suffering from a gunshot wound to the head in the 3500 block of Mannasota Ave. Mr. Williams was transported to Johns Hopkins Hospital by Medic 3 for emergency medical treatment. On 8/1/2022, Williams was removed from life support and would be pronounced deceased by Dr. Hwang at 1439 hours. An autopsy was conducted by Doctor Ali in which the cause and manor of death was ruled to be homicide by way of a gunshot wound.

Through the course of the investigation, both private and public surveillance footage was reviewed. Mr. Williams was observed meeting a subject later identified as Darries Sommerville (SID: 2777197) at Bel Air Road and Erdman Avenue. The two walked along Erdman Avenue then along Mannasota Avenue. As they are walking along Mannasota Avenue, Sommerville stops and reaches into his jacket and Mr. Williams continues to walk. A few seconds later, Sommerville is observed fleeing the scene on foot on Mannasota Avenue from the area where Mr. Williams was found suffering from a close contact gunshot wound to the back of the head. No other individuals were observed in this area at the time of the incident.

Witness(es) would identify Sommerville from photographs obtained from the surveillance footage.
