#### THIRD COUNT

The Jurors of the State of Maryland for the body of the City of Baltimore, do on their oath present that the aforesaid DEFENDANT, late of said City, heretofore on or about <u>June 17</u>, <u>2023</u>, at <u>4900 Sinclair Lane, Baltimore, Maryland</u>, did drive a motor vehicle in a careless or imprudent manner that endangered both property and the life of a person in a negligent manner; against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

#### FOURTH COUNT

The Jurors of the State of Maryland for the body of the City of Baltimore, do on their oath present that the aforesaid DEFENDANT, late of said City, heretofore on or about <u>June 17</u>, <u>2023</u>, at <u>4900 Sinclair Lane, Baltimore, Maryland</u>, did fail to control his speed while operating a vehicle in order to avoid a collision; against the peace, government and dignity of the State. ### **FIFTH COUNT**
