I, the undersigned, apply for statement of charges and a summons or warrant which may lead to the arrest of the above named Defendant because on or about 12/04/2022 at 5620 Woodmont Avenue Baltimore, Maryland 21239, the above named Defendant shot and killed Jada Burrell.

On 12/04/2022 at 0310 hours Dispatcher 22 notified the Homicide Unit via telephone Northeast District Patrol was requesting the response of a homicide detective for an adult female shot multiple times at the address 5620 Woodmont Avenue. Det. Sgt. S. Jones and Det. R. Moore responded to the scene at 0350 hours. Det. Moore assumed control of the investigation.

Det. Moore's preliminary investigation revealed at 0302 hours Officer D. Houchins responded to 5618 Woodmont Avenue for a discharging of

call for service. Upon arrival, the victim later identified as Jaymyra Jeannine Burrell, was located lying on the ground outside the apartment building 5620 Woodmont Avenue. The victim appeared to be suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Medic 18 responded to the scene and transported the victim to Johns Hopkins Hospital. Despite Medical intervention, the victim was pronounced dead at 0337 hours by Dr. Chaudhuri. The victim was identified by photo identification inside her purse. The victim's [REDACTED] was also at the scene and stated [REDACTED] was four to five months pregnant.

A canvass of the crime scene was conducted. Crime Lab Technician Harvey, Unit 5842, responded and processed the crime scene. Located at the crime scene was the victim's purse with a chain (on walkway), a swab of suspected blood (in the grass), and a paper bag (on the grass) with food (clear container w/shrimp) inside the bag. There was a metal fragment recovered from the front exterior step of the apartment building located 5624 Woodmont Avenue. A daylight canvass was conducted at the crime scene and ballistic evidence was recovered in front of 5620 Woodmont Avenue. Crime Lab Technician Forney, unit 5816, responded, photographed and processed the scene.

On 12/5/2022, Dr. Joseph Mininni performed an autopsy was conducted on Jaymyra Burrell at the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner. At the conclusion of the autopsy, Dr. Mininni determined Jaymyra Burrell was shot 9 times and the manner and cause of death was homicide by shooting.

The investigation revealed that victim's unborn child's father name was Malik McCormick and he lived at 7917 dalesford Avenue in Parkville, Maryland. In addition, Malik McCormick operated a gray four door sedan, Chrysler 200. According to a witness, the victim was last observed on 12/03/2022, around 1930 and 2000 hours, sitting inside the living room waiting for her boyfriend Mailk McCormick to pick her up to take her to get some food. The witness further stated the victim did not have a vehicle and her boyfriend, Malik McCormick, was her main source of transportation.

During a notification of the victim's death to Malik McCormick at his residence, Malik McCormick lied to detectives on body worn camera that he did not see the victim for approximately two days.

Multiple witnesses were located and interviewed. To protect the witnesses, the witnesses identities will be made available at court. A witness was located and interviewed, at which time the witness stated Malik McCormick confessed that he killed Jaymyra Burrell. Camera footage was also recovered from various locations and reviewed. In addition, evidence of domestic assault was recovered. Based on the information received from Malik McCormick's cell phone records, witnesses, and camera footage, Malik McCormick transported Jaymyra Burrell to 5620 Woodmont Court, at which time Malik McCormick shot Jaymyra Burrell several times with a 9mm handgun before he fled from the crime scene in his [REDACTED] car.

The Homicide of Jaymyra Burrell occurred in the City of Baltimore, the State of Maryland.
