**Recruitment for the**  
**Naturopathic Doctors Formulary Council**

**\* Seeking One Physician and One Pharmacist \***

There is a Naturopathic Doctors Formulary Council (“NDFC”) within the Maryland Board of Physicians (the “Board”). The NDFC is tasked with the following, in part:

- Develop and recommend to the Board a formulary for use by licensed naturopathic doctors; and
- Annually review the formulary adopted by the Board to determine if any changes are necessary for compliance with current prescribing standards or the practice of naturopathic medicine.

**The Board is seeking applications for two NDFC members:**

- **One licensed physician who practices in Maryland; and**
- **One pharmacist who has a background in pharmacognosy and who practices in Maryland.\***

*\* Note: All interested pharmacists are encouraged to apply. The Board may waive the “pharmacognosy” requirement, depending on the qualifications of applicants who submit resumes by the deadline.*

**The due date for the receipt of applications is noon on Friday, May 21, 2021.**

The term of an appointed member is four years. A member of the NDFC may not receive compensation as a member of the NDFC but is entitled to reimbursement for certain expenses, including travel.
