



Calling all advocates for the lower-income community! **Apply to serve on the Montgomery County Community Action Board!**

The Community Action Board advocates for policies that help economically disadvantaged residents move towards the Self-Sufficiency Standard. These include affordable housing, early childhood education, tax credits for filers with modest incomes, living wages, work supports, food security, and access to services. The Board serves as the governing body for the Community Action Agency and the Montgomery County Head Start program.

The County Executive seeks diverse applicants that represent different areas of the County to fill two vacancies in the low-income sector of the Board. Low-income representatives must be democratically elected by a group of County residents with modest incomes. Applicants must submit a letter that verifies the date of the election and confirms that the applicant is a resident with a modest income.
