ABOUT OUR WORKSHOP

With a special focus on phonemic awareness and the alphabetic principle, participants will learn how to systematically and explicitly support early literacy development in age-appropriate and playful ways.

We’ll break down key components of the Science of Reading – phonemic awareness, phonics, vocabulary, fluency and comprehension – and dive deeper into strategies that promote phoneme-level awareness and connect sounds to letters. Through hands-on activities, video examples, and collaborative planning, educators will walk away with a toolkit of practical strategies ready to implement in their classrooms.
