Responsible for 2,000 miles of County roads, 900 bridges, shoulders, sidewalks, curbs/gutters and driveway aprons. Also tasked with snow and ice removal, traffic signals, streetlights, fallen trees, unclogging drainage inlets and maintaining stormwater management facilities.

Office of Transportation — Operates the County's public transportation system

Office of Engineering and Program Management — Implements the Capital Improvement Program (CIP), including roadway reconstruction, bridge replacement, pedestrian safety and intersection improvements

Office of Highway Maintenance — Provides highway infrastructure, litter control and stormwater management from maintenance shops located in Brandywine, Forestville and Glenn Dale.
