NOTICE

This notice is given by Dan Phillips, Interim Director of the Maryland State Department of Assessments and Taxation (the "Department"), acting pursuant to Governor Wes Moore's (the "Governor") Executive Order 01.01.2024.10 dated March 26, 2024, declaring a State of Emergency related to the collapse of the Francis Scott Key Bridge, as it may be amended or renewed from time to time, and the Governor's Executive Order 01.01.2024.12, dated April 11, 2024, entitled "*Authorizing Suspension of Statutes, Rules, and Regulations Governing Grants, Procurements, and Temporary Assistance Programs Related to the Francis Scott Key Bridge Collapse,*" as it may be amended from time to time, after finding that the action(s) described herein are necessary to protect the public health, welfare, or safety and will not endanger the public health, welfare, or safety.

Maryland Annotated Code, Tax – Property Article, §11-101(a) requires, on or before April 15 of each year, that certain types of business entities submit an annual report to the Department. The failure to file this report or to request a filing extension under Maryland Annotated Code, Tax – Property Article, §14-704(c) will result in the entity initially being found "not in good standing" with the Department. If the delinquency persists, the entity will be eventually forfeited from doing business in the State of Maryland.

The Department is extending the 2024 annual report filing deadline from April 15, 2024 to June 17, 2024 regardless of whether a person has requested an extension. Any provision of law inconsistent with the Department's extension is hereby suspended.

This Notice is effective immediately and shall remain in effect until the State of Emergency has been terminated.
