

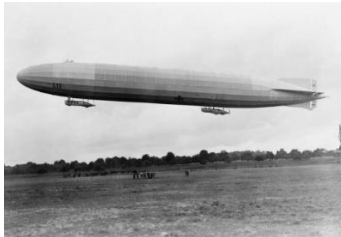


THE WFA EAST COAST BRANCH (USA) PROUDLY PRESENTS:

The Spring 2018 Symposium in World War I History!

Saturday June 9, 2018 – Spangler Hall – Lutherville, Maryland

Join us for an exciting day-long program featuring displays, refreshments, living history exhibitors, door prizes, and the following WWI presentations:

- “Zeppelins Vs. British Home Defense 1915-18” by Jon Guttman, based on his forthcoming book from Osprey Publishing
- “Building a National World War I Memorial: Why the process has lasted longer than the war itself” - Edwin Fountain, Vice Chair of the U.S. World War I Centennial Commission, recounts the complex history of this provides and update on progress.
- “A Rainbow Division Lieutenant in France: The World War Diary of John H. Taber” Stephen Taber provides a view into the discovery, editing and publication of the war experiences of a young officer in the 168th Infantry, 42nd Division during 1918.
- “Tannenberg 1914: The Aeroplane and the Evolution of Modern Warfare” - National Air & Space Museum Specialist Carl Bobrow examines the use of imperial German and Russian air assets in this new interpretation of WWI's Eastern Front.
- “An Updated Look at the Men of the Cameronians – Scottish Rifles” - Historian James Taub presents his work to synthesize military and social history into a unified treatment of a regiment's experience in World War I – based on his recent Masters' Thesis at the University of Glasgow.

The symposium will also feature a special silent auction of World War 1 aviation artwork sponsored by WFA East Coast and the League of WW1 Aviation Historians! Proceeds directly benefit the World War 1 Monument Project at the National Museum of the US Air Force!

Directions: From the Baltimore Beltway (I-695) follow signs toward Towson/Lutherville and exit onto northbound York Rd (Rt 45). Proceed approximately one-half mile then proceed west on Seminary Ave (Rt 131) for approximately one-half mile. Turn right at Francke Ave and the venue will be on your left in two blocks.
