
When: Saturday 27 October 2018. Doors open, refreshments, meet & greet 9:00 AM with opening remarks at 10:00AM.

Railroad St. and continue until reach N. Washington St. – Turn RIGHT on N. Washington one block. – Then turn LEFT onto Constitution Ave. Follow



this avenue onto the campus grounds. – Constitution Parking Lot will be on your right and can be entered by Penn Hall Dr. on the right or further up for direct entrance on the right.
