Epiphany Chapel & Church House is the only WWI Chapel in the United States. It is a National Register Site and restored with help from the Maryland Historical Trust. It features a WWI Social History Museum and a Chaplains' Peace Garden with bronze plaques naming 2928 WWI chaplains. The Chapel is hosting a Centennial Brass Concert open to the public as part of a *Day of Remembrance* featuring a musical composition commissioned for the Centennial which includes the tolling of the bell. Across the country bells will toll to honor those who served and commemorate the Declaration of the Armistice on November 11, 1918--*the eleventh day of the eleventh month at the eleventh hour.*
