



SEPARATED VETERANS CORPORATE FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

The Corporate Fellowship Program is a Maryland based program that connects recently separated veterans with the opportunity to gain experience with partner companies by completing six-week fellowships, with the goal of leading to meaningful employment.

The National Capital Region Corporate Fellowship Program is a Maryland-based program and is possible due to a \$4.3 million Department of Labor, National Dislocated Worker Grant awarded to Anne Arundel Workforce Development Corporation (AAWDC) and is offered in collaboration with Military Corps, Career, Connect (C3).

THE FELLOWSHIP

The Hiring Our Heroes Corporate Fellowship Program provides recently separated veterans with meaningful job opportunities. This 6 week program is held year round in the Maryland and D.C. areas.

Through this fellowship, individuals gain experience by working with participating companies and also have access to free educational services. The fellowship places qualified individuals quickly and is a great way to connect companies with a large pool of talent.

ELIGIBILITY

Separated veteran candidates must:

- Be separated honorably within the last 48 months. Retirees are NOT eligible for this program.
- Reside in Maryland or Washington D.C. for no more than 48 months or relocating to the area on orders.
- Must be unemployed or underemployed.



ALSO INCLUDED WITH ELIGIBILITY

- One on one career planning, coaching and preparation with a program manager.
- Resume and interview assistance available.
- In-demand industry credentials, certifications and licenses.



SCHEDULE

- The program lasts up to 6 weeks and is a paid, on-the-job training program with an hourly rate.
- Fellows will report to their respective company Monday—Thursday (32 hours/week).
- Concluding the fellowship, the candidate will either be hired or have the opportunity to interview for position with host company.
