Transitioning Service members

Who live in or are stationed in Maryland and are within 6 months of their transition from the military to the civilian workforce with an other than dishonorable discharge.

Maryland Veterans

That separated with an other than dishonorable discharge (not retired), from the military within the last 48 months, and are unemployed or underemployed.

Active Duty Spouses

Who relocated to Maryland within the last 48 months and are unemployed or underemployed.
