

**About the Scholarship**

The application deadline for 2022-2023 scholarships is **March 31, 2022**. The scholarship covers the full cost of tuition, fees, and course-required resources. The Pillars of Strength Scholarship Program is managed by UMGC and The Blewitt Foundation in association with the National Military Family Association.

**Eligibility Criteria**

To be considered for this scholarship program, you must be a spouse, parent, stepparent, sibling, stepsibling, fiancé, child, stepchild, or friend of a servicemember, or of a veteran, who became wounded, injured, or ill in the line-of-duty after September 11, 2001. Enrollment in the VA Caregiver Program or assignment as a DoD-designated non-medical attendant (NMA) is not required.
