VETERAN’S DAY 2021 GUEST SPEAKER

Wes Moore: Rhodes Scholar, combat veteran, bestselling author, small business owner and former CEO of one of the nation’s largest anti-poverty organizations.

A native of Tacoma Park, Maryland, Mr. Moore is a graduate from John Hopkins University and a Rhodes Scholar from Oxford University. Mr. Moore was a Captain with the U.S Army’s 82nd airborne and lead soldiers in combat in Afghanistan. Mr. Moore is the best-selling author of “The Other Wes Moore”, a story about the fragile nature of opportunity in America. Mr. Moore has written other best-selling books that reflect on issues of race, equality and opportunity, including his latest book “Five Days”, which tells the story of Baltimore in the days that followed the death of Freddie Gray in 2015.

Mr. Moore has been committed to tackling tough challenges. That commitment lead to a four-year term as CEO of the Robin Hood Foundation. During his tenure, the Robin Hood Foundation distributed over \$600 million dollars toward lifting families out of poverty.

Finally, Mr. Moore built and launched a Baltimore-based business called BridgeEDU. BridgeEDU reinvents freshman year of college for underserved students to increase their likelihood of long-term success.

Mr. Moore currently resides with his wife and two children in Baltimore City.
