

APPLY FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE NOW!

The price for home heating fuels and electricity is expected to be higher than normal this winter and could impact your bill. Check your bill each month to see what rate you are being charged.

You may be eligible for help with your **electric and/or heating bill** through the State Office of Home Energy Programs (OHEP).

- **Apply by Mail:** Call 1-800-332-6347 Mon-Fri, 8AM-4:30PM to request an application by mail.
- **Apply in Person:** Some local OHEP offices are open to the public. Call before you go to an office to make sure they can help you in person.

Thinking about applying for electric and/or heating bill assistance? You might be eligible for SNAP too!

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly known as food stamps, is a monthly benefit program that you can use to purchase food at the grocery store, online, and at farmers markets.

Eligibility is based on household size, income, and expenses.

Until the end of the federal public health emergency, SNAP benefits will be maximized for all eligible households. If you are eligible for SNAP, you will receive the **maximum amount** for your household size during this time.

Maryland Hunger Solutions can help you with:

- Learning about SNAP and where you can use your benefits
- Pre-screening your household for eligibility
- Completing an application over the phone (no internet required!)
- Filing a redetermination or recertification for SNAP
- Finding other local food resources
