The newly expanded VA Domiciliary at Perry Point VAMC is a 29 bed residential unit that offers up to six months of rehabilitation for Veterans needing housing and employment.

Private and semi-private rooms with private bathrooms are available. Male and female veterans are welcomed.

Off station privileges are allowed once orientation is completed. Personal vehicle are permitted if properly tagged and titled.



Service provided in a wide range of rehabilitation such as:

- Mental Health Care (Psychiatrist and Medications)
- Individual Therapy (Psychologist and Social Workers)
- Addiction Counseling
- Spiritual counseling
- Employment Specialist (Job search and Resume building)
- Residential Wellness Clinic
- Recreation Services (Equine therapy, golf, and Nature Walks)
