Gain knowledge about the new PACT Act which expands VA care and benefits for Veterans, qualifying family members or dependents of a deceased Veteran.

The PACT Act extends VA health care eligibility for:

- Veterans who may not have been eligible before
- Veterans who served in Vietnam, Cold War, Gulf War, and Post 9/11 eras
- Veterans who participated in a toxic exposure risk activity
- Veterans who participated in certain nuclear response cleanup activities

If you're a Veteran or survivor, you can file claims now to apply for PACT Act-related benefits.
