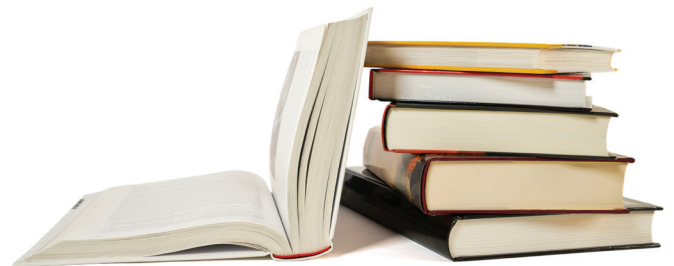
Participants should plan to attend all five sessions.
