Quickly, I realized the demanding physical work, ongoing planning, flower arranging, and interaction with people cleared my mind and provided a new perspective on life. There is great healing in digging in the dirt, planting a seed that grows into a beautiful bloom, and watching someone's face light up when they see it, it's a gift. In fact, there are numerous studies that support the positive outcome of Veterans utilizing gardening practices to improve their mental health and well-being. Our goal is to provide a therapeutic experience where Veterans can grow and care for flowers in a serene farm setting.
