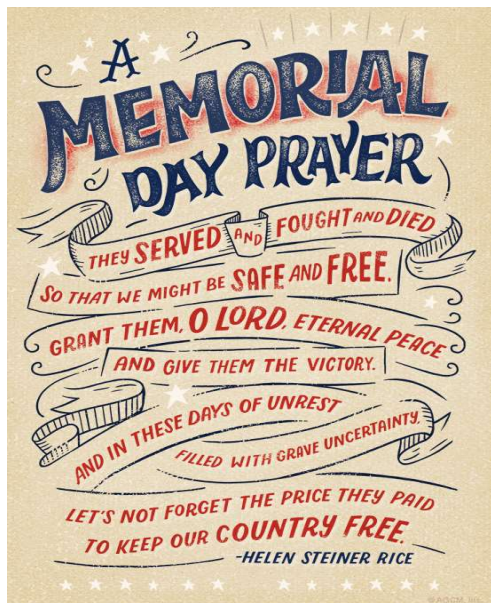


ESVC VETERANS DAY PROGRAM
