Vet Centers are community-based counseling centers that provide services to eligible Veterans, service members, and their families to see them through the challenges that come with managing life during and after military service.

Full-time students receive funding to cover up to **two years of school tuition** and approved fees, as well as a stipend, in exchange for six years of full-time work at one of more than 300 Vet Center locations after graduation. We encourage student Veterans with a desire to support their fellow Veterans to apply, although military service is not required to qualify for the scholarship. Recipients must be willing to relocate to meet the needs of the VA.
