Our WWII moms have passed, but they still wait, there are many empty spots that lie in the family cemetery plots across the state. A space for "her boy" to be laid to rest next to his mom.

The last two weeks of September are important for our Gold Star families. It begins with National POW/MIA Recognition Day and ends with Gold Star Mothers and Families Day on 29 September 2024.
