## Flu Shots from an In-Network Community Pharmacy:

- 1. Be sure that you received care through VA within the past 24 months to be eligible.
- 2. Find an in-network community pharmacy near you at <a href="www.va.gov/find-locations">www.va.gov/find-locations</a>.
- 3. Take your VA Veteran Health ID card, or another government-issued ID, with you.
- 4. Share this coding information with the pharmacy staff:

5. After you've received the flu shot, notify your VA primary care team during your next appointment or through secure messaging so it can be noted in your medical record.

## Flu Shots from the VA Maryland Health Care System:

- 1. Get your flu shot during a scheduled primary care appointment or at some specialty care appointments.
- 2. Come to one of our walk-in clinics for Veteran patients. The locations, days, and times are listed below:
