Don't be Scammed – The Bureau of Insurance Warns Public of False Websites Claiming to Represent the Fortify Maine Homes Program

The Bureau of Insurance is alerting consumers to beware of false websites claiming to represent the Bureau's new Fortify Maine Homes roof replacement program.

Consumers should avoid any websites not hosted by **www.maine.gov** that offer to check eligibility or provide information about the Fortify Maine Homes Program. They are not affiliated with the Program or the Maine Bureau of Insurance.

The Maine Bureau of Insurance website - www.maine.gov/pfr/insurance/home - is the only website where Maine consumers can access information about the Fortify Maine Homes Program.
