# What to know about participating and reserving space...

- If you're interested, don't delay! Submit the interest form to let organizers know you're interested!
- There are several ways to participate. Use the form to select any and all applicable interests.
- Organizers collect information through September.
- If awarded space, you should expect to follow timelines and requirements (e.g., participant terms and conditions, promotional information, payment, final event logistics and amenities etc.)

#### **Tentative timelines:**

- **July- September:** Use the interest form to submit requests to participate in conference sessions, exhibit space, and/or presentation/demo stage, and educational activity space
- October: Confirmation of awarded participation by show management. Billing and invoicing begins.
- **November**: Event scheduling and spaces assigned and announced by organizers. Additional event information published on show website. Tentative schedule and layout announced.
- **December**: Payments due for selected participants
- January: event happens Tuesday January 11- Thursday January 13, 2022

#### Returning features in 2022:

- Much of the show will remain unchanged from the 2020 layout, format, and planning
- Exhibit area: in the auditorium, attendees visit booths that target and serve agriculture and related sectors
- Conference: includes workshops, meetings and presentations, and continuing education credits
- Presentation stage: features current topics and demonstrations at auditorium center stage
- Resource room: space for service providers and attendees to connect, share info, and join dedicated Q & A or meet & greet sessions

# Added and updated features for 2022:

Responding to feedback, organizers plan to add technology apps and digital access, and expand advising opportunities. For example:

- Scheduling and space for attendees to connect with more ag service providers via one-on-one appointments
- Digital library of educational content—including sharing session materials
- Live broadcasting and recordings of select content—so people can tune in via Internet
- Access to key information about the show; available wherever an attendee has and uses Internet
- A one-stop place to digitally share contact information and event news and communications
- Interactive event agenda with downloadable components
