Maine Universal Immunization Program

Expanded to Include Adults

LAUNCHING JULY 2026

Expanding Access. Reducing Barriers. Supporting Providers.

Starting in July 2026, Maine’s Universal Immunization Program will expand vaccine access to adults aged 19 - 64 statewide, including those who are privately insured, under/uninsured and on MaineCare.

The program supports healthcare systems and providers in administering recommended adult vaccines at no cost to eligible adults, helping improve adult immunization coverage across Maine.



What Is the Universal Immunization Program?

The Universal Childhood Vaccine Program, launched in 2012, provides vaccines to children ages 0 through 18 years. In June 2025, legislation was passed, expanding access to adults ages 19 - 64.

Recommended vaccines for individuals ages 0-64 will be available through participating healthcare providers as part of a streamlined statewide system. Providers will be able to order vaccines through the Maine Immunization Program, for all eligible patients.
