



HOMEOWNERS PROPERTY TAX **ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**

Wayne County Property Tax Foreclosures suspended for 2020 but, you still must pay property taxes as normal. Use this time to apply for any available tax breaks and get on the right payment plan.

2020 Poverty Tax Exemption (HPTAP) **Deadline extended to December 14th**



HPTAP approved homeowners with delinquent taxes can enroll in Pay As You Stay (PAYS) Reduced Payment Plan Reduced Payment Plan.
