Lessons Learned in Developing an Effective Regional Ebola Concept of Operations (CONOPS) *Webinar on August 10, 2016, 2:00-3:00pm ET*

Developing meaningful and practical regional concept of operations plans for Ebola and other highly infectious diseases can be challenging and may, at times, seem daunting.
