CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The Michigan Public Health Association Epidemiology Section is calling for abstracts for the upcoming **Michigan Epidemiology Conference** to be held on **Friday, March 23, 2018 at the University of Michigan**, in Ann Arbor, MI. With about 250 registrants expected, attendees will represent a broad range of public health sectors.

We welcome abstracts from diverse disciplines including, but not limited to state and local health departments, academia (including students), infection control, non-profit organizations, international health, private industry, and health care networks. Poster Presentations

Visual representation of research and findings where presenters can interact one-on-one with attendees. Authors should be prepared to discuss their work during one of two 30-minute poster sessions (morning or afternoon to be assigned).

Oral Presentations

Formal presentation to a sub-group of attendees. Presentations will be strictly limited to 15 minutes, followed by a 5-minute question and answer period.

Submission Requirements

Please be prepared to provide the following information in the Abstract Submission Form link below.

- Authors and affiliations.
- Abstract including: title, introduction, materials/methods, results, and discussion. *Please limit the total text in this section to 250 words.*
- Preferred method of presentation: oral, poster, or either. *The review committee will accommodate these preferences as much as possible, but in some cases may request alternative presentation methods.*
- Presenting author information: name, phone number, email address, student or non-student, credentials, employer, mailing address, job title, presentation objectives and biographical sketch.
- Topic category of abstract.

DEADLINE: Abstracts must be received by February 5, 2018. Notification of abstract selection by February 26, 2018.
