What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will be reconstructing 22 miles of I-69 and six interchanges, replacing the 15 Mile Road bridge over I-94, repairing 26 bridges, and making drainage and safety improvements from south of I-94 in Marshall, Calhoun County, to Island Highway in Charlotte, Eaton County. Work also will include paving the Turkeyville Rest Area and carpool lot, and the Potterville Rest Area.

When Will This Be Done?

Work begins this fall and is expected to be finished in fall 2023.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Motorists should expect lane closures on I-69 and I-94, and intermittent ramp closures and county road closures over I-69 for bridge work.

Long-term Benefits

This project will improve the ride quality and safety of the I-69 corridor in Calhoun and Eaton counties.
