Testing will require an appointment through Quest's MyQuest™ online portal and app:

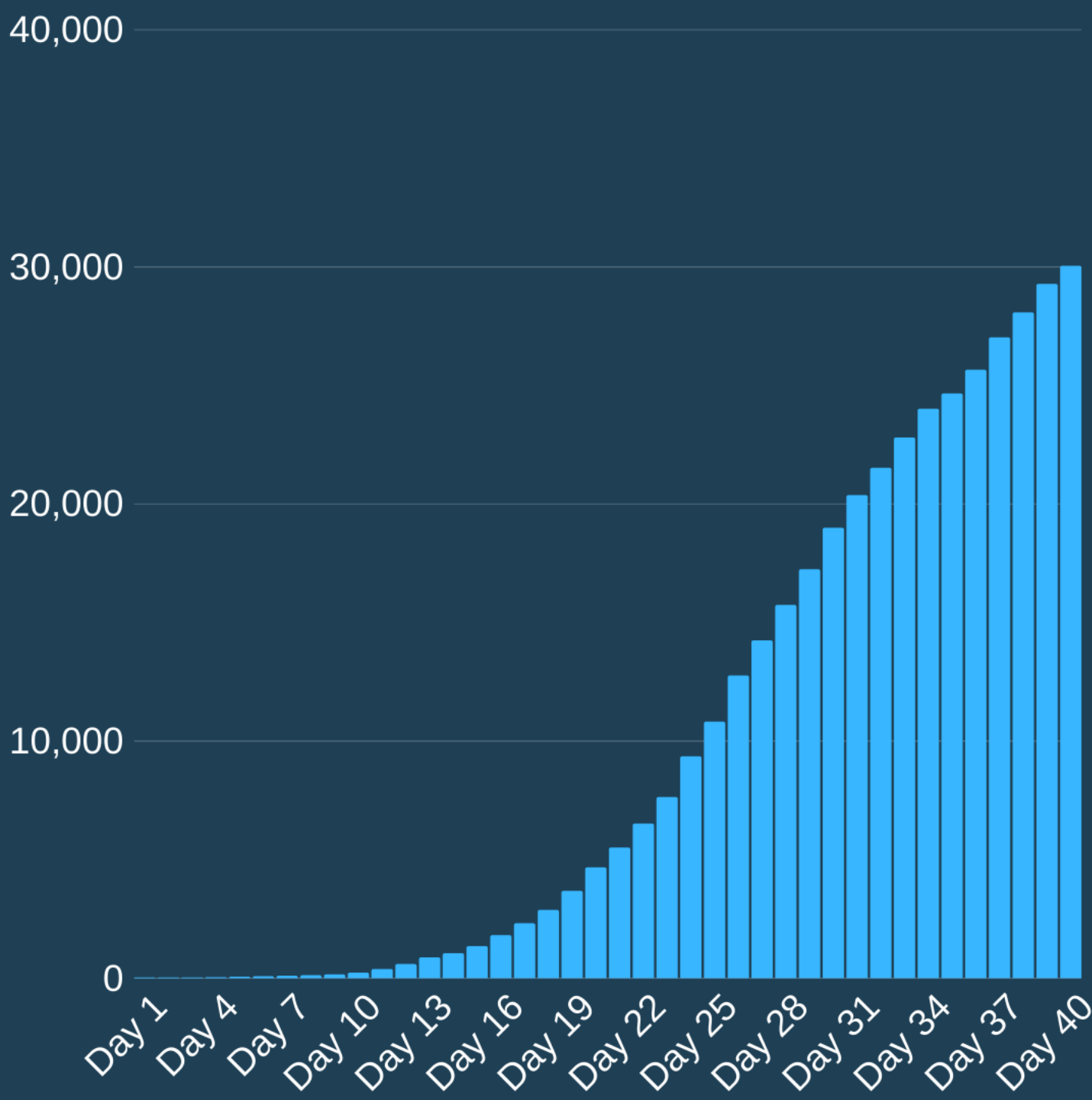

- **The MEDC announced on Wednesday that 12 small businesses and nonprofits around Michigan have been awarded a total of \$1 million through the Pure Michigan Business Connect COVID-19 Emergency Access and Retooling Grants program.**
- **Gardner-White Furniture has donated their fleet to COVID relief efforts.**
- **Walmart, Salesforce, and State Farm have teamed up to donate 500,000 masks, 100,000 gloves, and 50,000 shoe covers to Michigan.**
- **The Government of Taiwan donated 100,000 medical masks, which arrived today.**

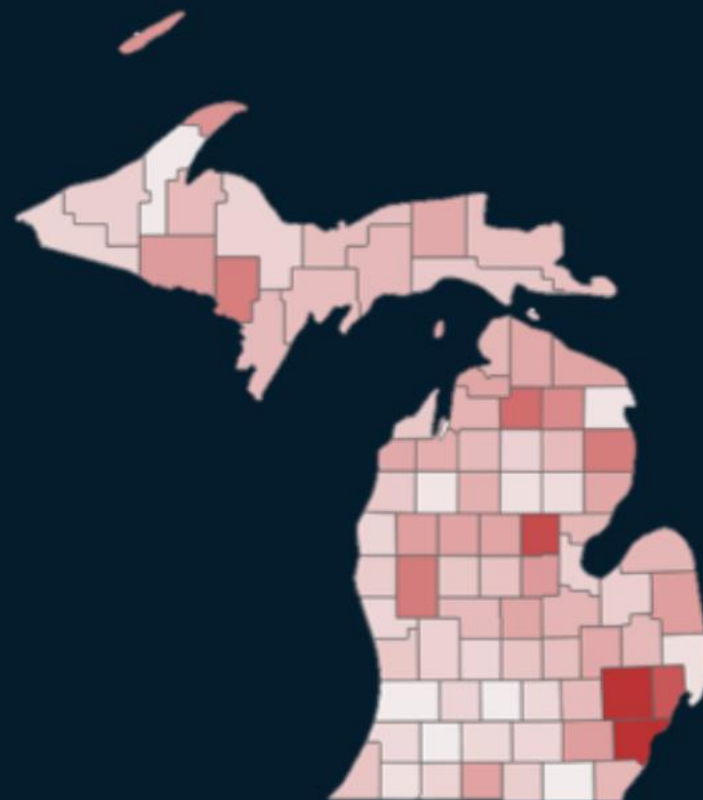


Current cases per million

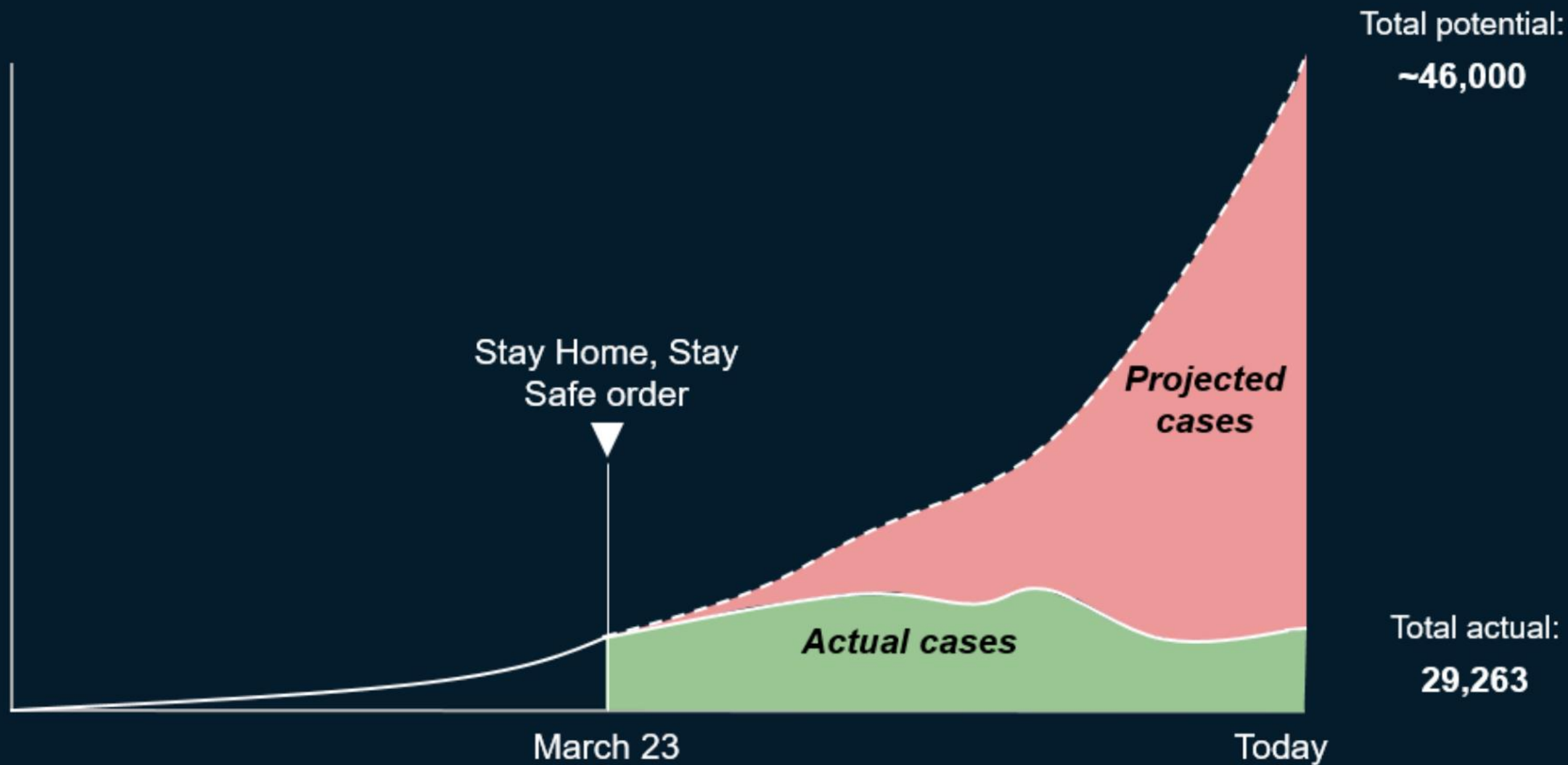
