- LIFTING THE REQUIREMENT THAT HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS DELAY SOME NONESSENTIAL MEDICAL, DENTAL, AND VETERINARY PROCEDURES STATEWIDE BEGINNING ON FRIDAY, MAY 29.
- STATEWIDE REOPENING OF AUTO SHOWROOMS, BY APPOINTMENT ONLY, ON TUESDAY, MAY 26.
- ALLOWING STATEWIDE RETAIL, BY APPOINTMENT ONLY, STARTING ON TUESDAY, MAY 26. STORES LIMITED TO 10 CUSTOMERS AT ANY ONE TIME.
- ALLOWING STATEWIDE GATHERINGS OF 10 PEOPLE OR LESS IMMEDIATELY, AS LONG AS PEOPLE ARE PRACTICING SOCIAL DISTANCING.
