Re: Notice of Revocation and Termination of Easement

Dear Mr. Yu:

Enclosed is a Notice of Revocation and Termination of Easement. This document provides formal notice to Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership, Enbridge Energy Company, Inc., and Enbridge Energy Partners, L.P., the corporate successors to Lakehead Pipe Line Company, Inc., that the 1953 easement granted by the State of Michigan to Lakehead Pipe Line and authorizing the operation of the dual pipelines in the Straits of Mackinac is revoked and terminated as of 180 days following the date of this Notice. As set forth in detail in the Notice, the easement is revoked for violation of the public trust doctrine, and terminated based on a longstanding, persistent pattern of noncompliance with easement conditions and the standard of due care imposed by the easement, which cannot be corrected or otherwise cured.

Please be advised that the Michigan Department of Attorney General has today filed an action for declaratory and injunctive relief in Ingham County Circuit Court to enforce the Notice and require Enbridge to cease operation of the dual pipelines when the revocation and termination takes legal effect in 180 days following the date of this Notice.
