The Challenge

Infrastructure is critical to growing Michigan's population and economy. That's why fixing the damn roads, bridges, and everything in between has been a top priority for Governor Whitmer. Since she took office, Michigan has fixed 20,000 lane miles of road and 1,400 bridges, supporting 118,000 good-paying jobs.

The Plan

Authorize the final \$700 million of the Rebuilding Michigan Plan. The five-year, \$3.5 billion plan has focused on fixing Michigan's most economically-critical roads while supporting over 45,000 jobs without raising taxes by a dime. The final round of bonding projects includes 94 right along the Detroit Airport, 696 from Southfield through Warren, and bridges in Battle Creek, Grand Rapids, and Erie Township.
