



Five-Year License Renewal for Internet Gaming and/or Sports Betting Suppliers and Operators

Dear Licensee,

The Michigan Gaming Control Board will soon begin issuing renewal notifications and conducting five-year licensing investigations for entities licensed under the Lawful Internet Gaming Act and/or the Lawful Sports Betting Act, based on the expiration date of your license(s).

Pursuant to the Lawful Internet Gaming Act and Lawful Sports Betting Act, a licensee intending to renew its license must submit a License Renewal Application, the applicable renewal fee, and any required Business Disclosure Form(s) and Personal Disclosure Form(s) at least 30 days prior to the license's expiration date.

All applications and disclosure forms must include properly notarized pages.

Any documents submitted in a language other than English must be accompanied by an English translation.

In addition to submitting fingerprints, non-U.S. key persons must submit, with their Personal Disclosure Form, a current Criminal Clearance Certificate and a tax clearance certificate issued by their national income tax authority.

After the renewal application(s), fee(s), and disclosure form(s) are submitted, supplemental information will be required as part of the renewal investigation. This supplemental information includes, but is not limited to, the last three years of bank and credit card statements for businesses and individuals associated with the renewal application. All required supplemental information not in English must be translated into English. Your cooperation is appreciated, as it will help expedite the renewal process.
