SENIOR NUTRITION PROGRAM

Wayne County Office of Nutrition Services make available a well-balanced meal to Livonia residents age 60 years and older. There are three basic nutrition programs.

- ▶ Liquid Nutrition: For those seniors who have difficulty swallowing solid food due to a debilitating disease or condition. A physician must complete the Wayne County Office of Nutrition Services medical form indicating the person's need for liquid meals. The eligible client or representative will be responsible for picking up the liquid nutrition once a month at a designated site. For additional information, please call 1-800-851-1454.
- Home-Delivered: For those seniors who are homebound, unable to prepare their own meals or unable to feed themselves. Hot meals are delivered on weekdays, frozen meals are available to clients who are cannot prepare food on the weekends. A physician, visiting nurse, family, friend or the senior resident can make the referral for Meals-on Wheels at 1-800-851-1454.
- Hot Lunch Program: For those seniors who are able to attend one of the two sites located in the City. Suggested Donation is \$2.25 for those 60 years of age and older.

SENIOR CENTER TRANSPORTATION BUS

The Senior Center Transportation Buses provide curb-to-curb rides within the City limit on a donation basis. Rides are available to local shopping districts, grocery stores, medical appointments, and to the Senior Center. Service hours are Monday thru Friday, 8:30 a.m.-4 p.m. ADVANCE RESERVATIONS ARE REQUIRED BY CALLING (734) 466-2555.

To make a transportation reservation, please follow these steps:

MEDICAL BUS

- 1. Monday-Friday!
- 2. 9:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m.
- 3. Monday-Friday the Civic Park Center offers a shuttle to Doctors' Offices within the City of Livonia and up to one mile outside the City Limits. Please contact (734) 466-2700 to make your advance reservation. There is no charge for this service (Donations Gratefully Accepted). This service fills up quickly so please call as soon as you know the date and time of your appointment. All Vehicles Are Wheelchair Equipped. Age 60 and over. Reservations accepted up to 90 days in advance. Maximum of two (2) rides per week. You must make your appointment so that you are able to get home before/no later than 2:30 p.m. When making your reservation, you must have the time of your appointment, the name, address and telephone number of your Doctor.
- 4. You will be asked your name, address, telephone number.
- 5. On the day of your scheduled appointment you must be ready for pick-up from your home 1 hour ahead of your appointment time. When you are ready to return home, the doctor's office must call the center for your ride to go back home.
- Wheelchair riders must be accompanied and their wheelchair must have footrests and brakes in working order.
- 7. No reservations accepted from Assisted Living facilities or Nursing Homes.

SENIOR CENTER & GROCERY/MALL SHOPPING S.C.A.N. BUS

- 1. Reservations will be accepted, up to, 7 days in advance.
- When making your reservation, you will be asked your name, address, telephone number and your destination.
- 3. On the day of your scheduled ride, you must be ready for pick-up from your home by 8:30 a.m.-10:30 a.m. Mall Shopping Days.
