The Bricks of Learning

TRAVELING WITH FRIENDS

Learn how RAG-funded supports, regional partnerships, and state resources can strengthen local improvement efforts. Participants will explore available supports and plan how to maximize them:

BRICK ROAD ASSISTANCE

Bring your questions, challenges, and planning needs. This flexible support session provides coaching, troubleshooting, feedback, and technical assistance tailored to your local context.

SEEING BEYOND THE EMERALD CITY

Examine student success through a whole-child lens that includes academic, behavioral, social, emotional, and engagement factors. Participants will consider how multiple systems work together to support student outcomes.

WHAT'S ALREADY IN THE BASKET?

Examine current programs, practices, and resources to identify strengths, gaps, and opportunities. Participants will explore resource equity through staffing, time, partnerships, funding, and access

CHECKING THE COMPASS

Design a monitoring system that tracks both implementation and impact. Participants will identify measures, develop monitoring routines, and plan for ongoing adjustment

FOLLOW THE DATA BRICKS

Explore multiple sources of data to identify strengths, needs, trends, and opportunities for improvement. Participants will learn practical approaches for turning information into action.

MAP YOUR JOURNEY

Explore the MICIP platform through guided reflection and hands-on interaction. Participants will navigate each stage while strengthening the connection between the process and their local improvement efforts.

BUILDING THE YELLOW BRICK ROAD

Define the core components of your strategy and create a shared vision for implementation. Participants will plan for what successful implementation looks like at the classroom, building, and district levels.

WHAT'S BEHIND THE CURTAIN?

Move beyond symptoms and student blaming to identify root causes within adult practices, structures, and systems. Participants will develop challenge statements that create a strong foundation for improvement planning.

SETTING THE DESTINATION

Learn how to move from traditional outcome-focused goals to system-focused goals. Participants will develop end targets, interim targets, and identify strategies that strengthen the systems that produce results
