

STATE POLICE INVESTIGATE FATAL HOUSE FIRE

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

February 20, 2022

CHESANING, MICH. At about 3:15 a.m., on February 20, 2022, Saginaw County 911 Central Dispatch received a call reporting a structure fire at a residence located 1500 block of Lincoln Road in Maple Grove Township. The dwelling was reported to be occupied at the time of the fire.

Upon arrival on scene, Michigan State Police (MSP) troopers found the residence to be fully engulfed in fire. Maple Grove Township, Chesaning, and Albee Township Fire Departments responded and worked diligently to extinguish the flames.

During fire department overhaul operations, the victim, a 71-year-old male, was located within the debris. The victim's name is being withheld pending notification of next-of-kin.
