

State Police Hunting Big Foot

MARSHALL, MICH. Michigan State Police (MSP) Troopers are investigating a larceny of a seven-foot-tall sasquatch lawn ornament that occurred on West End Rd near Heimbach Rd in Park Township, St. Joseph County. The larceny occurred on or after 03-22-2022. The sasquatch lawn ornament stolen can be further described as made of sheet metal material and a rusty brown color with various sharp edges to detail the fur of the sasquatch. It appears that the sasquatch was cut away from a steel post with a pair of bolt cutters or similar cutting instrument. Area residents advised a white panel van with dark driver and passenger side windows was observed parked in the area on 03/22/2022. The van was then observed turning around in the victim's driveway and leaving the scene Northbound towards Heimbach Rd.
