

TWO CADILLAC MEN ARRESTED FOR LARCENY FROM VEHICLES AFTER FLEEING FROM TROOPERS

WEXFORD COUNTY, MI. On Friday, April 8, 2022, at approximately 1:35 a.m. troopers from the Michigan State Police (MSP) Cadillac Post attempted to stop a vehicle for multiple violations on Simons Street near Crippen in Cadillac. The vehicle, a 1994 Camaro occupied by two 19-year-old Cadillac men, crashed as they attempted to flee.

The troopers attempted a traffic stop and the suspect vehicle sped off, drove over a curb, and crashed into a chain link fence and trampoline in the yard of a residence on Crippen Street. The driver, identified as Tyrone Demetrius Slusser, attempted to run from the crash, but was quickly taken into custody. The passenger, identified as Gaven Noah-Ryan Hawk, was arrested without incident. Upon further investigation, troopers discovered the two men had been stealing items from vehicles in the Cadillac area. The owners of the stolen items were identified, and their property returned. Both men were lodged in the Wexford County Jail. There were no reported injuries from the crash.

Slusser was arraigned today in the 84th District Court in Wexford County on one count of Flee & Elude Third Degree, one count Resisting & Obstructing Police Officer, and two counts Larceny less than \$200. His bond was set at \$10,000 cash surety. His next scheduled court appearance is on April 26, 2022, at 2:00 p.m.

Hawk was arraigned today in the 84th District Court in Wexford County on two counts of Larceny less than \$200. His bond was set at \$10,000 cash surety. His next scheduled court appearance is on April 27, 2022, at 9:00 a.m.
