STATE POLICE K9 TROOPERS LOCATE MISSING ENDANGERED WOMAN IN LIVINGSTON COUNTY

Livingston County, Deerfield Township: On 08/08/23 K9 officer, Trooper Jeff Schrieber and his partner Woodson from the Brighton Post were requested by the Livingston County Sheriff's Department to assist with locating a 45-year-old missing and endangered female who was last seen on 08/06/23 after being involved in a traffic crash near her residence. The K9 trooper with the assistance of two other MSP K9 troopers searched a large area for eight hours and traveled several miles. Canine Woodson located the subject in a corn field which was over three quarters of a mile from the original crash site. The subject was found lying on the ground with injuries that appeared to be suffered from the crash, and unable to move. While waiting for help to arrive a large storm came into the area bringing with it, lightning and a severe downpour. With the help of his GPS, Trooper Schrieber was located by two other K9 officers and a trooper from the Brighton Post. Rather than wait for medical help to arrive, the troopers carried the injured subject several hundred yards through corn fields and woods to the waiting ambulance. The subject was transported to Genesis Hospital for treatment.
