

MICHIGAN STATE POLICE INVESTIGATE A WANTED FUGITIVE

Hillsdale Township, Hillsdale County, MI. On April 9, 2024 at approximately 1:00 p.m., the Michigan State Police First District Fugitive Team and the Michigan State Police Emergency Support Team were preparing to conduct a search warrant on a room at the Baw Beese Inn for a wanted fugitive.

The 26-year-old suspect from Calhoun County had a valid warrant for his arrest out of Jackson County. The subject was arrested, and a suspected explosive device was located in a vehicle the subject was in. The Michigan State Police Bomb Squad responded to the scene and secured the suspected explosive device. The suspect was lodged at the Hillsdale County Jail pending additional charges regarding this on-going investigation.
