MSP INVESTIGATING OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING IN DELTA TOWNSHIP Search Underway for Wanted Suspect

Delta Township, Eaton County. On Friday, April 12 at approximately 7:55 a.m., members of the Michigan Department of Corrections (MDOC) Absconder Recovery Unit were following a vehicle in the 1700 block of Willow Highway in Lansing Township that was occupied by a parole absconder who was wanted on numerous felony warrants to include aggravated assault. As the vehicle entered Delta Township, the suspect, who was a passenger in the vehicle, exited with a handgun and fired at the MDOC vehicle. The agents returned fire. Preliminary investigation indicates that neither the agents nor the suspect was struck by gunfire. The suspect then returned to the vehicle and fled the area.

The MDOC agents followed the vehicle as it pulled into the Westland Center Plaza at Waverly Road and W. Saginaw Highway, where the suspect fled from the vehicle on foot, running eastbound from the shopping plaza. The suspect vehicle, a black Jeep Patriot, also fled the area. At this time, neither the suspect nor the vehicle have been located. Canine units are in the area, along with additional law enforcement officers, searching for the suspect.

The suspect (whose photo is included below) is Marcus Gamba Oglesby, a black male, 31 years of age from Jackson, Mich. Oglesby is 6'1" and 135 lbs. He was last seen wearing all black clothing. Oglesby is considered armed and dangerous. If you see Oglesby, do not approach him and call 911.

The Eaton County Sheriff's Department, Lansing Township Police Department and Lansing Police Department are assisting in the search for Oglesby.
