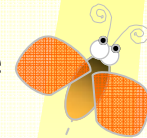

When reserving seats online please be sure to enter the **specific** event name where required. Full names of everyone in your party are required when making reservations. Persons who register online will be contacted via email for the names in their party. All names must be received by 12pm three days (72 hours) prior to the event to facilitate boarding on your cruise day.



### **Frequently Asked Questions.**

Q: Where will I board the boat?

A: You will board the boat at 425 Glengary at the DNR public access site.

Q: Is the boat handicap accessible?

A: Yes! The first deck of the boat is handicap accessible.

Q: Is there a bathroom on the boat?

A: Yes, the Grand Princess has a full bathroom on board.

Q: Can I bring my own cooler or drinks on the boat?

A: No, a cash bar will be provided.

Q: Can I use my Debit or Credit Card at the Cash Bar on the boat?

A: No, the bar on the boat can ONLY accept cash.

Q: Are there seats on the boat?

A: Seating is provided unless otherwise stated at the time of reservation.

Q: What happens in bad weather?

A: Our policy is safety first. We leave this up to the discretion of the captain at the time.

Safety of passengers is always the first consideration. If the Grand Princess is unable to cruise because of inclement weather, any scheduled events will still happen on the boat dockside.

The final decision to cruise or not to cruise remains with the boat captain and no refunds will be issued.
