



**VIOLATION TYPES**

**Priority (P):** The highest risk violations which are directly related to an increased risk of foodborne illness. Examples include improper handwashing, unsafe food temperatures.

**Priority foundation (Pf):** Violations that can create a high risk (Priority) violation. Examples include lack of soap at a handsink, no calibrated thermometer, no test strips to check sanitizer levels.

**Core (C):** Lower risk violations. Examples include general maintenance of facility (floors, walls, ceilings).

**Correction Requirements:** (P) and (Pf) violations must be corrected immediately when possible. Follow-up inspections occur to ensure all of these violations have been resolved if not corrected during the routine inspection. Open Core (C) violations are verified at the next routine inspection.

**ROUTINE INSPECTIONS COMPLETED LAST WEEK**

**ENFORCEMENT TYPES**

When violations repeat at multiple inspections, or active managerial control is not demonstrated, enforcement may begin. The following steps of enforcement exist.

*Civil Citations: Generally issued when a Core (C) Violation repeats at multiple routine inspections*

*Pre-Enforcement Step: Risk Control Plans (RCP)*

*Step 1: Compliance Conference*

*Step 2: Administrative Consultation*

*Step 3: Informal Hearing*

*Step 4: Formal Hearing*

*Consent Agreements: Alternative to formal hearings where establishment signs a legally binding agreement to correct violations or voluntarily close.*

**Action:** Describes whether an additional opportunity to comply was granted and is done at the discretion of the department.

*Proceed - Enforcement actions are being taken*

*Reprieve - Enforcement is being postponed*

*Conditional - A reprieve is being temporarily granted based on specific actions that must be taken immediately by the establishment*
