VIOLATION TYPES

<u>Priority</u> (P): The highest risk violations which are directly related to an increased risk of foodborne illness. Examples include improper handwashing, unsafe food temperatures.

<u>Priority foundation (Pf)</u>: Violations that can create a high risk (Priority) violation. Examples include lack of soap at a handsink, no calibrated thermometer, no test strips to check sanitizer levels.

Core (C): Lower risk violations. Examples include general maintenance of facility (floors, walls, ceilings).

Correction Requirements: (P) and (Pf) violations must be corrected immediately when possible. Follow-up inspections occur to ensure all of these violations have been resolved if not corrected during the routine inspection. Open Core (C) violations are verified at the next routine inspection.

ENFORCEMENT TYPES When violations repeat at multiple inspections, or active managerial control is not demonstrated, enforcement may begin. The following steps of enforcement exist. Civil Citations: Generally issued when a Core (C) Violation repeats at multiple routine inspections Pre-Enforcement Step: Risk Control Plans (RCP) Step 1: Compliance Conference Step 2: Administrative Consultation Step 3: Informal Hearing Consent Agreements: Alternative to formal hearings where establishment signs a legally binding agreement to correct violations or voluntarily close. Action: Describes whether an additional opportunity to comply was granted and is done at the discretion of the department. Proceed - Enforcement is being postponed Conditional - A reprieve is being temporarily granted based on specific actions that must be taken immediately by the establishment
